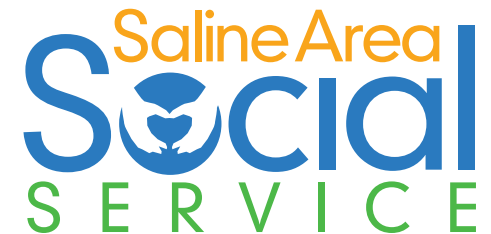

Neighbors Helping Neighbors

Their needs are great, yet the resources available to meet them are limited. It takes so much to provide our families in need with the aid, tools, and connections they need to improve their lives. This is why Saline Area Social Service depends on your help.

For our struggling neighbors, these contributions will mean so much.

Nearly 10% of Saline Area Schools students get free or reduced-price lunches each school day.

Who We Serve

Saline Area Social Service assists families and individuals within the Saline Area Schools district who fall within the district's low income financial guidelines. Our agency provides services to 300 to 400 people per month. Children account for 35% to 40% of the people we serve. Seniors living on meager fixed incomes account for another 25%.

Almost 7% of Saline households received Food Stamps or SNAP benefits within the past year.

What We Provide

- A food pantry, diapers, toiletries, laundry detergent, and paper products
- Limited assistance with rent, energy bills, and prescription co-pays
- Back-to-school clothing and supplies
- Personal items – such as eyeglasses, backpacks, and children's musical instruments and supplies – as donated by churches, service organizations, foundations, and individuals
- The Holiday Adopt-a-Family Program, which matches our families with generous adopters for the Christmas season
- Referrals to government agencies and additional resources that can help our families with specific needs

Neighbors Helping Neighbors
